The Rebbe was accustomed, especially since 5748, to *mechalek* a number of *kuntreisim*. Below you will find a chart, containing all of the *chalukois* – *seforim* distributions - along with its many details, some of them which you may have never been aware of before!

The Rebbe asked many of those who passed if they were 12/11. To each and every person who received this <i>ma'amar</i> – which deals with the concept of <i>zichuch hamidois</i> (refining one's middos) and <i>Ahavas Yisroel</i> – the Rebbe said, "Hatzlacha'dikeh Lernen". <sup>2</sup>

This ma'amar, Dibur Hamaschil "Veshavti B'Shalom", is the longest ma'amar which the Rebbe was ever magiha. – edited. This was done in honor of the 10th anniversary of this Yom Tov. The Rebbe asked many of those who passed by if they were shluchim. To one who answered that he was a mashpiya, the Rebbe did not give a kuntres, saying "Ich nem far zich oichet nisht!"

That night, the Rebbe gave out the *kuntresim*. It was not long before all of the *kuntresim* ran out. The Rebbe told the *mazkirus* that they should go and print more. They said that they would print 3000 copies. The Rebbe asked them, "Why print 3000?" They went ahead and printed 5000 copies.

				On that day (Chof Ches Sivan 5751) the Rebbe had gone to the Ohel. When he returned, he davened Mincha, said a Sicha, and then proceeded to daven Ma'ariv. The Rebbe was then scheduled to give out the Kuntreisim. The Gabbai, was asked to make a break in order to give the Rebbe a chance to rest up from standing on his feet for so many

				hours, before beginning the chaluka (which would last another few hours). The Gabbai announced that since the kuntreisim have not yet arrived from the printing press, there would be a break. Following the break, the Rebbe would then begin the distribution. In truth, the kuntreisim had already arrived. Following this announcement, the Rebbe said, "Onshtot machen a hefsek, vet men machen a hemshech". He then began to say a second sicha. This sicha was later edited by the Rebbe, becaming the famous kuntres "Mikdash me'at, zeh beis Rabeinu shebebovel"
